## **Progress Report of the Community Sports Committee**

## **INTRODUCTION**

This paper reports on the work of the Community Sports Committee (CSC) since the last update to the Sports Commission (SC) in December 2015.

## **PROGRESS UPDATE**

2. At the 39<sup>th</sup> CSC Meeting on 3 March 2016, Members discussed the following issues.

#### **Sport For All Day 2016**

3. The LCSD will organise a "Sport For All Day" on 7 August 2016. Free programmes will be held at the designated sports centres in the 18 districts, and many facilities will be open for free public use on the event day. "Scale New Heights" will be the theme of the event to encourage people to nurture a good habit of doing exercise, to maintain a healthy lifestyle and develop sporting culture in the community.

# The 6<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Games

4. The 6<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Games (HKG) will take place in 2017. To facilitate early preparation of the Games and the launching of publicity programmes, the 6<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Games Organising Committee (OC) will be formed in April 2016. As in previous HKG, the OC will comprise representatives from the CSC, the 18 District Councils, the Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, concerned national sports associations, HAB and LCSD.

## **KEY ITEM TO BE ADDRESSED**

5. The key items that the CSC will address in the coming months are overseeing the implementation of the "Sport For All Day 2016" and the preparation of the  $6^{th}$  Hong Kong Games.
