INTRODUCTION

This paper reports on the work of the Community Sports Committee (CSC) since December 2020.

PROGRESS UPDATE

Report from the Territory-wide Physical Fitness Survey for the Community Advisory Committee (AC)

2. The Consultancy Service Contract has been awarded to the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) in October 2020. The CUHK was invited to present its proposal, covering the methodology, test items, implementation schedule and contingency plan at the 4th Advisory Committee meeting held on 14 January 2021. Members were also consulted on the publicity strategies and use of IT equipment for conducting the survey. The LCSD will take follow-up actions on the decisions to prepare for commencement of the Survey in due course.

Report on Sport For All Day 2021

3. The Sport For All Day (SFAD) is tentatively scheduled for 1 August 2021. The LCSD will follow up on the preparation of the SFAD having regard to the infection control measures imposed by relevant authorities. Details of the event will be announced in due course.

Report of the 8th Hong Kong Games Organising Committee

4. In response to the suggestion made by the Standing Committee members of the 8th Hong Kong Games (HKG), a series of webinars on sports, mental health and wellness are being held from February to April 2021. Video recordings of the webinars will be uploaded to the HKG dedicated website and social media platforms after the live sessions.

5. The Physical Fitness Association of Hong Kong, China has been engaged to design three different sets of fitness exercises. Sports ambassadors and elite athletes have been invited to demonstrate the exercises with Cheering Larry, the mascot of HKG. Video recordings of the demonstration, with the HKG theme song as background music will also be uploaded to the HKG dedicated website and social media platforms in April 2021.

Hong Kong and Shanghai Summer Sports Camp for Youth 2021 (the Sports Camp)

6. The Sports Camp will be held in Shanghai this year. Details of the event are yet to be confirmed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The LCSD will follow up with the Shanghai Youth Training Management Centre under the Shanghai Municipal Sports Bureau on the arrangements of the Sports Camp.
