Progress Report of the Community Sports Committee

Introduction

This paper reports on the work of the Community Sports Committee (CSC) since the Sports Commission was last updated in March 2021.

Progress Update

2. At the 49th CSC Meeting on 6 May 2021, members discussed the following issues:

Report from the Territory-wide Physical Fitness Survey for the Community Advisory Committee (AC)

3. To ensure the viability of survey, four pilot tests with a small number of samples were conducted in May 2021. A Charter Signing Ceremony was conducted at Tsuen Wan Sports Centre on 30 June 2021. The full implementation of data collection of the Survey will be conducted from July 2021 to January 2022.

Proposal on Sport For All Day 2021

4. The Sport For All Day (SFAD) 2021 will be held on 1 August 2021. LCSD will arrange free use of leisure facilities and organise a series of free recreation and sports programmes in the 18 designated sports centres from 2 pm to 6 pm on the event day. Dance will be the focal sport for promotion. In addition to dance demonstration and play-in sessions, the elements of the Olympic sports will be included for public participation this year so as to show support to the Hong Kong athletes participating in the Tokyo Olympic Games and Paralympic Games. To encourage public participation at home or other place on the event day, a live webcast of sports demonstrations will also be arranged.

Hong Kong and Shanghai Summer Sports Camp for Youth 2021 (the Sports Camp)

5. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Sports Camp will be postponed to the next year in Shanghai. The LCSD will follow up with the Shanghai Youth Training Management Centre under the Shanghai Municipal Sports Bureau on the arrangements of the Sports Camp.

Amendments of the Standing Orders of the CSC

6. With a view to streamlining the administrative work of the CSC, the CSC Secretariat proposed to revise the relevant clauses of standing orders. Members were briefed in detail and endorsed the revised standing orders at the meeting.

Introduction to the LCSD's Edutainment Channel

7. The LCSD launched the Edutainment Channel since December 2020, a new one-stop online platform covering informative and learning materials on aspects of culture and leisure. Members were briefed in detail and expressed their views.
