Progress Report of the Elite Sports Committee

INTRODUCTION

This paper reports on the work of the Elite Sports Committee (ESC) since the last update to the Sports Commission (SC) in July 2015.

PROGRESS UPDATE

2. At ESC's meeting on 7 December 2015, representatives from the Hong Kong Sports Institute (HKSI) presented the following two items for Members' information and comments –

(i) The Five Year Strategic Direction of the HKSI

As HKSI's redevelopment project has been completed and the current financial year is also the final year of its 2011-2015 Five Year Strategic Direction, the Institute is in the process of reviewing its current strategic directions and drawing up new strategies for the next five-year period. ESC Members noted the review and progress of the HKSI's Five-Year Strategic Direction for 2011-2015, and the proposed strategic directions from 2016 to 2020 which will be considered by the HKSI's Board of Directors.

(ii) Coach Education

HKSI is providing a range of coaching services to meet the needs of athletes on behalf of the Hong Kong Coaching Committee, a joint committee under the HKSI and Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, for the development of sports. At the meeting, ESC Members were informed of the latest development of the coach education programmes.
